*After admission to candidacy, the student chooses a faculty mentoring committee, consisting of at least three IMSE Graduate Faculty members, including the Ph.D. mentor, who are well-qualified to evaluate and help the student in his/her thesis research. The student must inform the Graduate Program Administrative Assistant of the names of the Ph.D. mentor and committee members. The members of this committee will be part of the Thesis Examination Committee. The Ph.D. mentor (thesis advisor) must be an IMSE Graduate Faculty member with the title of Professor, Associate Professor, or Assistant Professor. **The student should meet with his/her mentoring committee at least once per semester until the completion of the Ph.D. to review progress in thesis research.** More frequent meetings may be appropriate in some cases. Every December, or more often in the case of unsatisfactory progress, the committee will send a report on the student's progress to the IMSE Graduate Studies Director (via the Administrative Assistant). If the members of this committee change, please submit an updated copy to the IMSE.*
